How we plan to do it:

1. Kindly park your cars in the parking lot (only 50 cars are allowed at a time).
2. At the scheduled time, walk to the front of the church under the covered area with your masks on and keeping 6' apart (except families).
3. After blessing the ashes, Deacon Terry and Fr. George will drop a few grains of ashes on your head with prayers.
4. Go back to your cars and drive off using the main entrance (so that cars that may be waiting on the road can come in through the Food Bank entrance).
