#### PROJECT ADVANCE 2021 Our Way Forward

Last year (2020), the total collected was \$23,910.00. After deducting the Archdiocesan goal of \$10,000 and our portion of archdiocesan expenses which was \$1,828.66, the total rebated back to the Parish was \$12,081.34. This year (2021) our commitment to the Archdiocese will be \$15,000. As of May 31st, 2021, parishioners have pledged \$6,790. When you look at the interior and exterior of the church you can easily see that improvements are needed. Fr. George has prioritized some items that he would like attended to sooner rather than later: new flooring for the sanctuary, an up-to-date audio-visual system, an upgrade to the exterior lighting, and overall general maintenance including emergency breakdowns (very recently we had to have some work done on the boiler because of its loud clanging). This year, Project Advance will be our only fundraiser; so we will be depending on the support of all parishioners to make "Our Way Forward". Cheques are to be made out to Project Advance and dropped in the collection box in front of the sanctuary.
