2021 Saint Joseph Parish Financial Report

Below you will see the 2021 financial results for our Parish. We would like to thank all parishioners for their financial contribution, as well as their volunteer work in the Parish, both are valued and appreciated. Thank you!

Financial Highlights

As we noted in 2020, and anticipated for 2021; with Covid impacting fewer people attending services, no annual Bazaar and many household incomes being reduced; revenue available for Parish operations is still down from 2019 levels. To appreciate the extent of how much revenues are down, the main operating funds for the Parish come from Regular Collections, Building Fund Collections, Project Advance Rebate, Candles/Vigil Lights and finally Events & Fundraising. These 5 key revenue streams are down over \$92,000 from 2019 levels.

Due to Covid, some upgrades were put on hold and Fr. George was successful in keeping expenses down. We are very pleased to announce that for 2021, Revenues exceeded Expenditures by \$95,450.

Our parishioners and other community members were also very generous this year to the Food Bank. Food Bank donations are included within the total of "Charitable Works".

Our recent Finance Committee meeting concentrated on financial long-term planning for the Parish, including establishing a contingency fund. The contingency fund will help ensure future financial stability. We also determined that we have \$250,000 currently available, to put towards many of our outstanding current and even urgent needs. We would like your input into identifying and prioritising these items. Some items discussed by the Committee included carpeting, needed electronics, upgrades to the hall kitchen, heating systems and lighting. We cannot do it all within the current budget, hence we want to hear from you!
