Archbishop Miller's Easter Message:

Dear brothers and sisters in the Risen Lord: "I have risen and I am with you still."

May these words resound in all of our hearts as we celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus this Easter. After his death on the cross. He has conquered sin and death by rising from the tomb.

We joyfully shout that Jesus is alive. He is our hope. He is with us in our disappointments, our hardships and our doubts. He is with us even when we stray and cannot find our way back to him. The Risen One is always there for us, our families and our parish communities.

With the liturgical Easter Sequence, as pilgrims of hope during this Jubilee Year, we gladly repeat: "Christ, my hope, is risen!" During this year of grace, we are recipients of this new and living hope of eternal life.
