St. Joseph's Parish Breakfast!

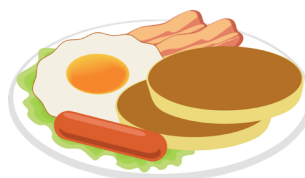
Everyone is invited to join us today downstairs in the parish hall for Breakfast!

Cash or Interac at the door while quantities last.



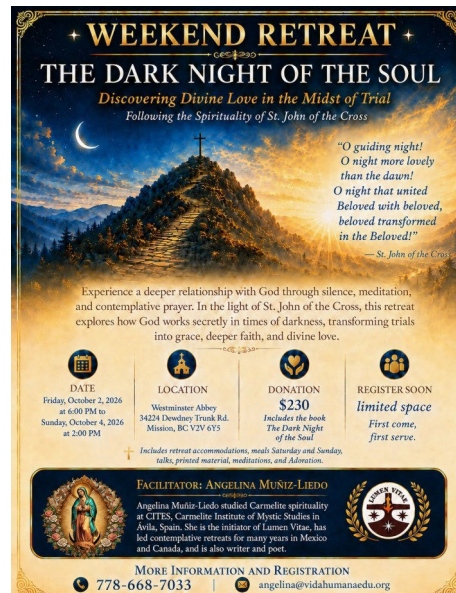
